The Stonnington People's Panel consists of 40 randomly selected community members who are geographically and demographically representative of the Stonnington community. Panel members will be asked to consider a range of Council priorities and prepare a draft 2040 Community Vision for Stonnington.

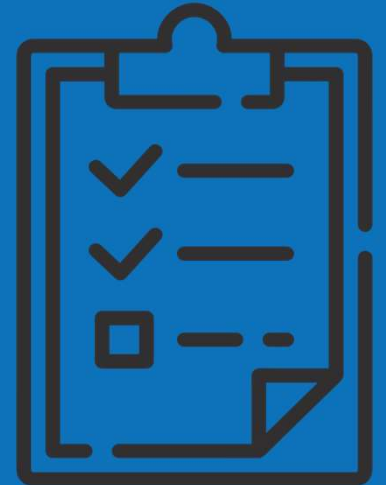
